- Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with groups and individuals with diverse or competing interests or perspectives

- Extensive knowledge of Nova Scotia Mathematics Curriculum

### Responsibilities:

Mathematics Support Specialist will have the responsibility of supporting provincial mathematics learning, grades 7 -12, with a particular focus on planning for a review of 7-12 curricula and updating mathematics pathways at high school grades. The Mathematics Support Specialist will lead project work with the provincial math team and EECD colleagues to support the implementation of research -based, inclusive instructional strategies within an MTSS model, assessment and revision of curriculum, and the design and selection of learning resources. The specialist will work with the regional centres of education, CSAP, and department staff to support student success in mathematics. The Mathematics Support Specialist will also work with key education partners such as teacher work groups, universities, colleges, other departments and agencies, professional associations and organizations, and advocacy groups to assist in informing the development of mathematics curriculum and supporting success for learners in mathematics.

We are looking for someone who has a passion for mathematics; is a proven educational leader; who wants to be part of an innovative team; and who wants to make a difference in supporting student achievement in mathematics!

### **Application Instructions:**

This is a two-year position with an option to renew for a third year.

Interested candidates who are qualified should apply in writing to the EECD, including cover letter, resume and references, by August 24, 2018. Interviews will be held on August 27 and 28.
