

The Regional Crest

The Chignecto-Central Regional Crest emphasizes the commitment of the Board and staff to enable students to achieve their greatest potential as lifelong learners.

At the centre of the crest, an adult holds the hand of a child, symbolizing our commitment to lifelong learning and interdependence.

In the background, the lamp of learning has four white bars representing the four municipalities within our Region. The three gold bars are symbolic of the boards that were amalgamated.

The flame of the lamp lights up the horizon and the world of possibilities to those who aspire for knowledge. The base of the crest is formed by the region of Chignecto-Central.



Colours

Purple > the colour of dignity and courage, signifies our commitment to leadership, to helping students develop the courage to pursue what is right, while always respecting the dignity of self and others.

Blue > the colour of thinking and organization, the blue circle represents the global village in which we live. The blue horizon symbolizes the sky and sea and our desire to help our young people strive for new knowledge and greater understanding of our world.

Green > the colour of new ideas and possibilities, symbolizes earth and growth and our need to recognize the importance of nurturing our young people and caring for our environment.

White > the background of the crest is symbolic of universality, fairness, and goodness. It signifies our sincere intentions to serve all students through equality of educational opportunities.

Gold > The gold ring surrounds the crest symbolizing purity of intention and commitment; our intention to strive honestly, and without prejudice, on our students' behalf; and our commitment to provide meaningful and relevant educational opportunities for our children - our future.
